Mrs Thorley & Ms Giorgio ran a workshop on Bookmaking, I did the middle section on levels of comprehension and high order reading comprehension skills and Mr Watts ended the day with some hands on STEM activities that teachers could use with students to promote engagement, problem solving and the use of digital technologies.
